Black Cumin Seed Forte: Support Fat Metabolism and Much More*

Black Cumin seed has been used for centuries as a spice, preservative and remedy. The seeds have a hot, peppery taste and are often added to curries, cheeses and breads. The common name in Arabic means "seeds of blessing". 1.2 Eleven archaeological finds just in Egypt alone, trace the presence and use of the plant from around the 28th century BC through to Roman times – this includes a number of dried seeds located in a pot within Tutankhamun's tomb (around 1323 BC).3

Ancient sources mention Black Cumin seed as a panacea, with application to a wide range of conditions.^{3,4} A panacea is a universal remedy – one that can be used for many applications. Traditional texts record a long history of use for Black Cumin seed across several traditional systems with many actions, applying to many body systems.^{2,5,6} Black Cumin seed has also been used traditionally to support fat metabolism.^{5*}

Supports digestion, a healthy liver and the metabolism of fats

In the herbal tradition of India, some herbs such as Black Cumin seed are used to promote "digestive fire". Strong digestive fire supports good health, such as vitality, healthy immune system function and clear thinking, and assists the elimination of potential toxins from undigested food. Black Cumin seed can also provide a balancing effect or metabolic support for the typical Western diet.5*

Bitter and pungent are two traditional qualities of Black Cumin seed that support the metabolism of fats, as well as the health and normal functioning of the pancreas and liver. This may occur, at least partly by:5*

- invigorating sluggish pancreatic function
- promoting efficient metabolism of fats in the adipose tissues (body tissues composed of fat cells)

Black Cumin seed is also used traditionally to support the healthy functioning of the liver.^{5,7*}

Supports well-being and vitality

Avicenna, a Persian physician born in 980 AD, referred to Black Cumin seed as a restorative that supports the body when tired and dispirited.^{2,8*}

Encouraging results from a clinical study suggest that Black Cumin seed increased vitality in women aged 37 to 71 years who took it at a daily dose of 1.6 grams for 3 months. Those that did not take Black Cumin seed did not experience this effect. A placebo-controlled trial found healthy male adolescents were more contented after taking Black Cumin seed (0.5 grams daily) for 4 weeks. 10*

Supports antioxidant activity

Free radicals are highly reactive substances created in the body that may affect cells by interacting with proteins, lipids (fats) and DNA – potentially causing protein oxidation, lipid peroxidation and affecting DNA. Antioxidants help protect cells from the damaging effects of excessive free radicals, 11 and are thought to support general health. 10

Superoxide dismutase is one of the main antioxidant enzymes that are part of the body's antioxidant defense system.¹³ Glutathione is not an enzyme, but is produced in the body and works with some of the antioxidant enzymes. There are numerous measures of oxidative stress, including for example, malondialdehyde (MDA, the oxidized product of lipids).¹⁴

A clinical trial found that Black Cumin seed increased blood levels of glutathione in those that took it at a daily dose of 2 grams. The improvement was noticed from 3 months through to 12 months. ¹⁵ A clinical trial found that 2 grams of Black Cumin seed taken daily for 6 weeks decreased MDA in the blood. ¹⁶ Those that did not take Black Cumin seeds did not experience these effects. ^{15,16*}
