How ChelaCo Keeps You Healthy

Supports the body's natural defenses against environmental insult, encourages the healthy function of the organs of elimination and supports normal cellular defenses

In an uncontrolled trial, a Garlic supplement was found to support good health in workers exposed to pollution in an industrial setting. The trial researchers compared the initial test results with those obtained after one to three months' use of Garlic. They suggested that Garlic may have helped cleanse the worker's intestines. The sulfur constituents of Garlic may have done this by chelating or grabbing any intestinal toxins that may have been present. The toxins could then be eliminated from the body in the feces.^{1*}

A diet rich in polyphenolic compounds such as flavonoids and procyanidins from, for example, fruit, vegetables and pulses (legumes: peas, beans, lentils), supports good health, particularly in the gastrointestinal (GI) tract.^{2,3} These compounds are thought to help keep the stomach and intestines healthy from reactive substances present in foods or generated within these organs. The flavonoids and procyanidins are in contact with the tissues of the GI tract after being swallowed, so their beneficial effect might be due to direct contact.^{2,4} They might also increase levels of normal toxin-metabolizing or antioxidant defense enzymes in the GI tract. (Antioxidants help protect cells from the damaging effects of excessive free radicals (highly reactive substances created in the body).) There is also another way that these polyphenolic constituents may help. Dietary iron is usually not completely absorbed, especially among those on a typical western diet. Unabsorbed dietary iron enters the feces, where it could provide a challenge to the large intestine. Polyphenolic compounds, by chelating (grabbing) iron may help to alleviate the oxidizing actions of intestinal iron.² As the leaf and flower of Hawthorn contains flavonoids and procyanidins they may support the body's natural defenses against environmental insult and support the healthy function of the large intestine.*

A review of controlled clinical trials found that concentrated Milk Thistle seed extract may support liver function by helping ensure the integrity of liver cells.⁵ The flavanolignans of Milk Thistle do this by providing protection from the damaging effects of excessive free radicals,^{6,7} and by eliminating toxins.^{6*}



We are increasingly exposed to environmental pollutants. Toxic metals occur naturally in the environment and as a byproduct of industrialization. Exposure to toxic metals can occur from cigarette smoking, dental amalgams, leaded gasoline, lead paints (which may be found in old houses), water, air, cosmetics and also food such as fish.8*

The chelating or binding of toxic metals by herbs has been evaluated in test tube experiments. The following graph shows the results for concentrated Milk Thistle seed extract (Silymarin), Garlic, Hawthorn leaf and flower, a combination of these three herbs, and Cilantro. (Cilantro is an herb that is often assumed to be a good binder of toxic metals.) The closer the value to 0% the better the binding (because the herb grabs the metal), the closer the value to 100% the less active the herb. The results indicate that the best binding occurs with the combination of concentrated Milk Thistle seed extract (Silymarin), Garlic and Hawthorn. Interestingly, Cilantro showed very poor binding activity.*
