What does Regeneplex contain?

Carotenoids

Regeneplex contains a number of pigments called carotenoids. These compounds, such as lutein, beta carotene, alpha carotene, lycopene, and zeaxanthin, have a structure that helps them manage potentially damaging molecules like free radicals and reactive oxygen species that naturally occur in the body. Lycopene also supports skin smoothness. Carotenoids in general provide support against skin reddening and photo aging.[†]

Buckwheat

Both buckwheat flour from the plant seed and buckwheat juice from the plant's leaves and stems provide plant chemicals linked to cellular protection from free radicals. Rutin, linked to decreased capillary fragility, is found in the juice and seed, while buckwheat flour provides small amounts of vitamin E.[†]

Zinc and Vitamin C

Zinc is abundant in the top two layers of our skin, the epidermis and the dermis, as well as in connective tissue. Vitamin C plays an essential role in supporting collagen creation. Both zinc and vitamin C have the potential to protect cells from damage by free radicals. Mild zinc deficiency, while not generally considered an area of concern for the population at large, is more prevalent in certain subgroups of the population and has been linked to roughened skin, among other concerns.[†]

B Vitamins and Coenzyme Q₁₀

Both the B-vitamin complex and coenzyme Q_{10} support the body's energy pathways and protect cell structures. B vitamins also support digestion and the circulatory system, both vital to proper delivery of nutrients throughout the body.[†]

How Regeneplex Keeps You Healthy

In a double-blind, randomized, placebo-controlled study of 76 men and women who took the product for nine months, the authors found that:[‡]

- > Those taking the skin health formula had fewer wrinkles around the eyes.
- > There was a strong trend for shallower wrinkles in the group taking the product.
- > When asked to grade "aesthetic improvement" of their skin, the product group was more likely to choose "improved," "much improved," or "very much improved" when comparing photos taken at different intervals during the study to photos taken at the beginning of the study. These results were published in 2011.

By combining key ingredients such as carotenoids, buckwheat, zinc, B vitamins, vitamin C, and tuna oil, Regeneplex supports all three layers of the skin (epidermis, dermis, subcutaneous); supports the body's ability to protect cells; and supports the body's cellular energy pathways, function, and structure.
